

TUITION

Some tuition is subsidised (mostly very small groups), and some is private (individual or small group, parent pays directly to the tutor). Lessons take place both in and out of school time. This year we have 18 specialist itinerant teachers and music experts. The cost of lessons currently ranges from \$7 to approximately \$20 per week depending on the instrument and length of lesson. There are some subsidies and sponsorships available. Tuition is offered in the following instruments:

Vocals, Flute, Bass guitar, Trumpet, Trombone, Keyboard, Piano, Violin, Acoustic, Electric and Classical Guitar, Clarinet, Saxophone, Cello, Double bass, Beat Boxing, Drums, Scottish Drumming, Bagpipes

There are about 200 students receiving music tuition and in music groups in the school this year. Fusion dance through Flow Academy is also an option.

INSTRUMENT HIRE

A few instruments are available for hire through the school at very reasonable costs: clarinet, flute, trumpet, violin, saxophone and cello. Otherwise most instruments are hired from music shops or privately owned.

MUSIC FACILITIES



The Performing Arts Centre includes four state of the art teaching and rehearsal rooms as well as a computer music suite, recording studio and media room.

CLASSROOM MUSIC

This is taught within each syndicate.
